The drums are designed so that no two side-plate mounting bolts are in line along the same grain of wood. This design balances the stress on the shell so the congas sound better and stay in tune longer.

The low profile, curved rims are oversized. The head does not come in contact with the sides of the shell, allowing it to vibrate more freely for a loud, full tone.

Rhythm Tech congas have protective rubber bottoms for playing at floor level, and come complete with adjustable basket stands.

It's important to see the wood. Rhythm Tech Oak Congas have a beautiful natural finish with double chrome-plated hardware. We use only chrome plating because it's the most durable.






